- Enjoy the countryside views as you head to the enchanted Chanticleer Garden in Wayne for your guided tour at 10:30 (90 minutes or a 60 minute option).
- Three short miles away is Terrain's Café in Devon with a seasonally changing brunch menu and greenhouse décor that blurs the lines between indoor and outside space.
- Satiated and inspired, you're just four minutes away from Jenkins Arboretum & Gardens. Jenkins hosts the Delaware Valley Daffodil Show (April) and the Delaware Valley Iris Society Flower Show (May) and much more throughout the year.
- Indulge in leisurely retail therapy in downtown Malvern or plan for an evening in nearby Philadelphia aboard the Spirit of Philadelphia (approximately 35 minutes from Malvern).

- Begin with a cozy breakfast at your hotel or consider stepping out to a fabulous Saturday brunch at Sovana Bistro, Kennett Square.
- You're now fueled up for a group stroll through the amazing Longwood Gardens.
- Depending on how long you plan to stay, you may purchase group gift cards to use at **The Café** (fresh and ready-to-eat selections) or **1906** for a full-service, relaxing lunch.
- Later, a 7-minute drive whisks you to Chaddsford Winery for a guided tasting.
- Before heading back to your hotel to freshen up for dinner; stroll through Kennett Square. A classic Main Street, Kennett offers plenty of locally owned shops including The Mushroom Cap and Mrs. Robinson's Tea Shop.
- For dinner, there are options at every price point and cuisine. Two upscale standouts that know how to host a group: Brandywine Prime Seafood and Chops at Chadds Ford Inn or The Gables at Chadds Ford with an amazing seasonal menu, patio dining and a piano lounge.

 Champagne Sunday Brunch at Mendenhall Inn will start your day off in Ritz style.

DAY 3

- From here, you're a short 8 miles to the glorious Nemours Mansion and Gardens, Wilmington, DE.
- Keeping with the Ritz, you're 10 minutes from Winterthur's Costuming THE CROWN exhibit and 40 of the Royal Family garments featured in the Netflix special open now through December 2019.
- The Millstone Café at Brandywine River Museum of Art is a relaxing setting for a lovely lunch and opportunity to enjoy the fabulous fine art collection of the famous Wyeth family.
- Dinner at the historic **Dilworthtown** Inn in nearby West Chester, caps the perfect stay.
